Workshop Minuets - November 10, 2015

The Town Council for the Town of Weaverville held a Workshop on November 10, 2015, at 4:00 P.M., in the Conference Room, at 30 South Main Street.

Present: Mayor Dottie Sherrill, Vice Mayor John Penley  
Council Members Doug Dearth, Doug Jackson, and newly elected Patrick Fitzsimmons and Andrew Nagle.  
Town Manager Selena Coffey, and Shelby Shields.

Mayor Sherrill called the meeting to order. She welcomed and congratulated Mr. Fitzsimmons and Mr. Nagle as newly elected Council Members, and Vice Mayor Penley on his re-election.

**Committee Appointment Recommendations:**

A. Weaverville Economic Development Commission.

Mayor Sherrill recommended the appointments of Patrick Fitzsimmons and Council Member Doug Jackson. Council Member Dearth requested to be removed from the WEDC.

B. ABC Board Liaison.

Mayor Sherrill recommended the appointments of Andrew Nagle and John Penley, replacing the retiring Council Members Currie and Knoefel as Liaison on the ABC Board.

C. Land of Sky Regional Council.

Mayor Sherrill recommended that Patrick Fitzsimmons replace out-going Gene Knoefel.

D and E.

The Conservation Board and Patriotic Board members will remain the same.

F. MSD.

Mayor Sherrill recommended that Al Root continue as the Town's representative on the MSD Board.

G. MPO.

Mayor Sherrill recommended that Council Member Dearth remain on the MPO.

H. Animal Appeals Committee

Mayor Sherrill recommended the appointment of Beth Palien for a term of three (3) years, Harold Payne, a two (2) term, and Don Moffitt, a one (1) year term.

**Schedule of Future Workshops:**

After a discussion on a time and date for the Bi-monthly workshops, it was the consensus to

schedule the workshops on the **2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday at 5:00 PM of the odd months.** The next workshop will be held on Tuesday, **January 25, 2016 at 5:00 P.M.**

**Other:**

Town Manager Coffey informed the Council of a request from the USA Cycling National Championship - Criterium to bring the 2016 "Nationals" to Weaverville on May 16, 2016. It would require several of the residential streets to be closed all day. The matter will be discussed further at more research is done.

Ms, Coffey stated that she has been approached again by the Garden Club to use the kitchen facilities in Community Room. This will be discussed further at the January Workshop.

Ms. Coffey reported that the window between the kitchen and Community Room has been installed.

Mayor Sherrill asked if there was a possibility of lighting the new Lake Louise sign. The question was asked if there was any more consideration of another entrance sign on Weaver Boulevard. Ms. Coffey will look into the matter of lighting the Lake Louise sign, and report back. Council Member Dearth stated that he would investigate the right-of-way issue with Rick Tipton, a DOT engineer, and report back.

There being no further business, the motion was made by Council Member Jackson, seconded by Council Member Dearth to adjourn the meeting.
