The Town of Weaverville, in cooperation with Official Payment Corporation, now offers the opportunity to pay property taxes and water bills via the Internet. This service is safe, reliable and in accordance with all state and government regulations. In order to process your payment, Official Payment Corporation, the credit card service provider **charges a nominal convenience fee based on the amount of the transaction.**

To pay by credit card, call the toll free number 1-800-272-9829 or visit [www.officialpayments.com](http://www.officialpayments.com) to pay Weaverville property taxes or Weaverville water bills online. For telephone payments, enter Weaverville's jurisdiction code 4322 when prompted.

You will be asked to enter the following information:

- Type of fee
- Bill or invoice number
- Credit card information
- Amount of Payment

The system will tell you:

- The total of your payment, including the convenience fee
- Obtain approval of charges
- Provide you with a confirmation number. Be sure to write down your confirmation number as a record of your payment. The charge will also appear on your credit card statement: The payment amount on one line, the convenience fee amount on a separate line.
