

Employment Opportunity Town of Weaverville

The Town of Weaverville Public Works Department is now accepting applications for full-time employment with the Town of Weaverville - Lawrence T. Sprinkle Water Treatment Facility. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age. Hire will be enrolled (paid by employer) in and must successfully complete NC Water Treatment Grade C Surface Water Certification course and pass Operator Certification examination as condition of employment. If currently Certified as Surface Water Treatment Plant Operator in the State of NC your hire pay will be commensurate with combination of Certifications, Education and Experience. Candidate must possess a valid North Carolina Driver's License and have the ability to obtain a NC Commercial Driving License "B" with tanker endorsement within 6 months of hire date (employer covers cost). For a more detailed description, request the **Water Treatment Plant Operator/Operator Trainee** job description. Opening is for night shift, typical work week is 4 days -10 hours per day, Wednesday through Saturday. However, candidate must be willing to work as required to maintain water services. Hire will be extensively trained and must achieve certification prior to independent operation without supervision. Drinking water treatment is a challenging and rewarding career field with excellent benefits and job security. Benefits include full Town paid health insurance for employee, Local Government State Retirement Plan, up to 6% match 401K, and more.

- 1.) Position Title: Water Treatment Plant Operator / Operator Trainee
- 2.) Pay Grade: 16. Entry Wage \$ 31,362.24 per year \$15.078 per hour for Non-Certified Operator Trainee. Trainee would be eligible for up to a 10% pay increase upon obtaining NC - C Surface Certification, and NC-CDL Class B with Tanker endorsement. Hire will be eligible to receive an additional 5% end of probation increase after successful demonstration of ability to operate facility independently. Grade C – Surface holder hire in rate would be a minimum of \$ 34,846.34 and is eligible to receive a 5% increase upon obtaining CDL with Tanker endorsement and successful completion of training to operate the facility independently. Certified Operators training, education, experience and certifications will be considered when determining starting wage offering. You may be eligible to receive higher wage rate than listed herein.
