

Lake Louise Fishing Rules and Procedures

1. Individuals fishing must follow all Rules and Procedures established by the North Carolina Fish and Wildlife Commission
2. Anyone over the age of 16 must have, in addition to any required North Carolina State fishing license, a fishing permit issued by the Town of Weaverville.
3. Yearly permits will be good for 12 months from the date of issue.
4. Only one pole per person.
5. Black Bass must be 12 inches in size to be retrieved and kept.
6. Maximum daily creel limit on all fish is 12 including Black Bass.
7. Maximum daily creel limit of Black Bass is 5 fish.
8. Fishing is allowed only during daylight hours.
9. No boats or other floatation devices of any type will be allowed on the lake.
