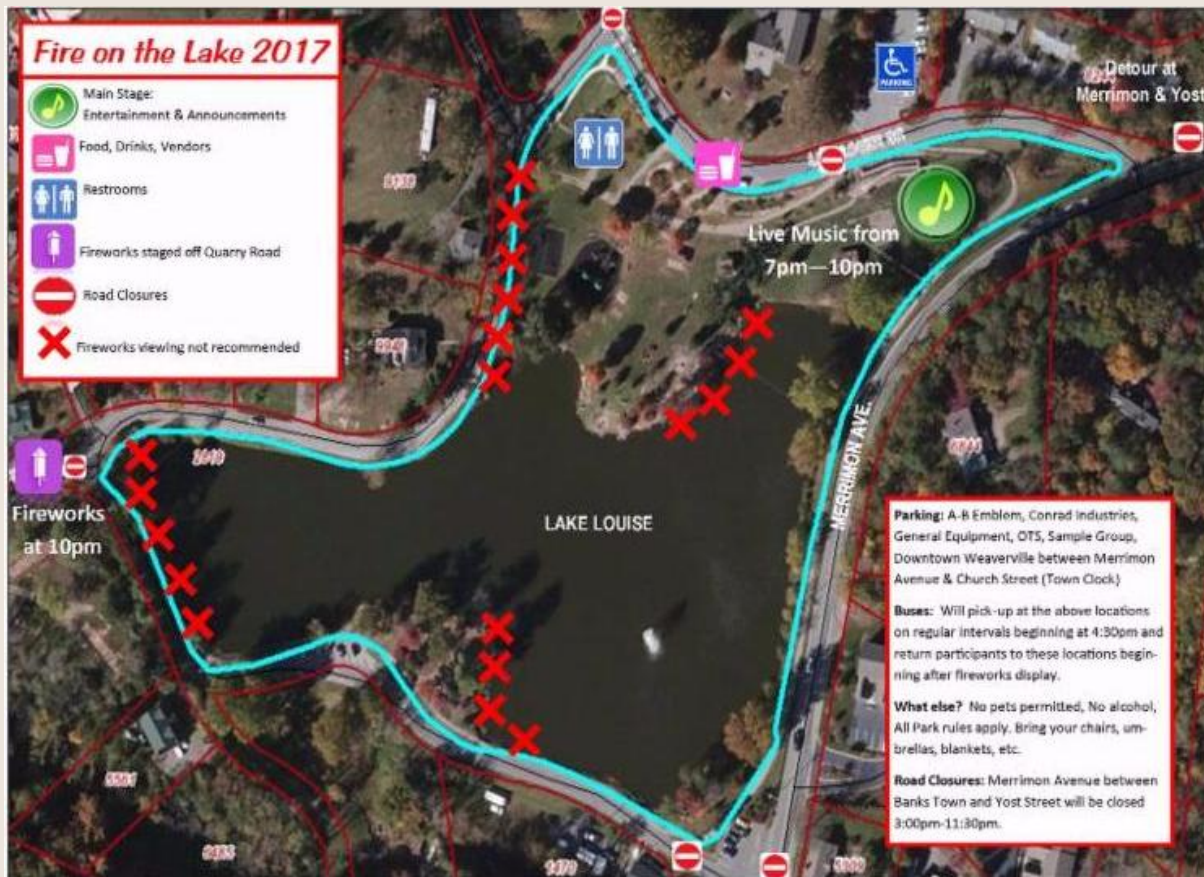

What you need to know about the July 4th Celebration

Locations for best viewing of fireworks: The Town will be staging and shooting fireworks from the same location as last year. The fireworks will be fired from Public Works, off Quarry Road. This will allow more space for our crowd to enjoy the show by opening Lake Louise Drive to pedestrians. The map above shows those areas where you may not be able to see the fireworks most dearly, due to trees around Lake Louise.

Road Closures:

- **3:00pm - 11:30pm:** All traffic traveling on Merrimon Avenue toward Main Street will be redirected

onto Banks Town Road.

- **3:00pm - 11:30pm:** All traffic traveling on Merrimon Avenue toward Asheville will be redirected onto Yost Street.
- **3:00pm - 11:30pm:** No vehicular traffic will be allowed to travel on Merrimon Avenue between Yost Street and Banks Town Road.
- **3:00pm - 11:30pm:** All traffic on Highland Street will be detoured toward Church Street.
- **3:00pm - 11:30pm:** No access onto Lakeshore Drive from Highland Street.
- **3:00pm - 11:30pm:** Lake Louise Drive, Lakeshore Drive (from Lake Louise Drive around the lake to Merrimon Avenue) will be closed to motorized traffic.
- **3:00pm - 11:30pm:** Quarry Road, Hyer Hill, St. Brown Place, Highland Street, Lakeshore Drive, Church Street, College Street, Metcalf Drive, Willamette Circle and other residential areas behind Lake Louise will not be accessible via Lake Louise Drive or W. Lakeshore Drive- PLEASE TAKE ALTERNATE ROUTE.
- **Lake Louise Drive will remain closed until July 5, 2017 @ NOON**

Parking & Buses: Parking will be available at the following at A-B Emblem, Conrad Industries, General Equipment, OTS, Sample Group, Downtown Weaverville between Merrimon Avenue & Church Street (Town Clock). Buses will pick-up at the above locations on regular intervals beginning at 4:30pm and return participants to these locations beginning after fireworks display.

What else? Remember, we can't allow pets for the event and alcohol is not permitted. All Lake Louise Park rules apply. Bring sunscreen, umbrellas, chairs, blankets, etc. and get ready for a great time!

Firecracker 5k: July 4, 2017

Join us Tuesday, July 4, 2017, for the 24th Annual Firecracker 5k Run to provide scholarships for some of our North Buncombe students planning to attend a college or technical school.

Course

The course begins at PNC Bank on Weaverville Boulevard, turns right onto Main Street and continues through residential neighborhoods and parts of beautiful downtown Weaverville, concluding back at PNC Bank.

To Get There:

From North of Weaverville

Take 19-23 South/Future I-26 East to Exit 19 (US 25/70). Turn left at stoplight onto Weaver Boulevard and go 0.4 miles. PNC Bank will be on your left.

From South of Weaverville

Take 19-23 North/Future I-26 West to Exit 19B. At top of exit ramp turn right onto Weaver Boulevard and go 0.2 miles. PNC Bank will be on your left.

Town's e-Focus Newsletter to go Completely Electronic in August

In January 2016, Town Council permitted staff to purchase and utilize an e-newsletter software to replace the previously printed and mailed Town newsletter. This was approved in an effort to save tax dollars amounting to between \$5,000 to \$10,000 dependent on the numbers of pages, hard copies, mailing costs and design by an outside vendor. The goal at that point was to mail out the e-Focus for only a short period of time in order to make certain that those who wished to receive the e-Focus could do so by signing up on the Town's website. We now have 344 e-Focus subscribers and feel that enough time has been provided for those interested in the e-Focus to make the transition from hard copy to the electronic version. As we have continued to mail the e-Focus out, the Town continues to incur costs for staff time, printing costs and postage expenses. In addition, the e-Focus is not formatted nor was the software developed for direct printing, therefore the printed versions sometimes do not look professionally developed. For the above reasons, the Town has decided to discontinue mailing the e-Focus after this edition. Should you wish to receive a hard copy of the e-Focus, we are happy to print a copy if you will drop by Town Hall to retrieve it. Again, this edition will be the last e-Focus to be mailed via 'snail mail'.

Thank you to all of you who have signed on to receive the e-Focus. You have allowed the Town to move forward technologically and with cost-effectiveness in mind!
