Please Help Protect our Crews!

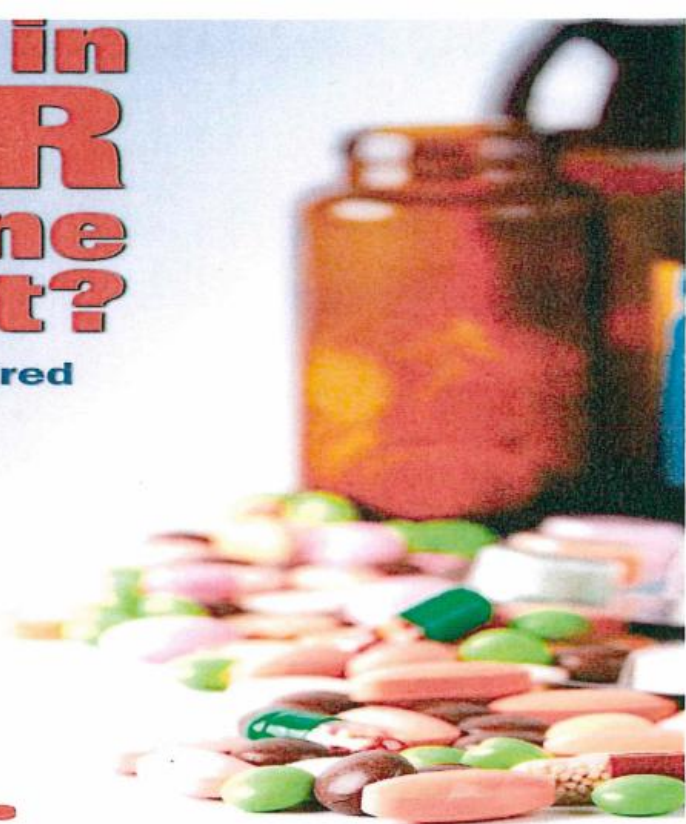
Our Public Works staff recently received a call from a citizen who wished to warn them about a dangerous condition in a brush pile. We are thankful for this thoughtful call because a landscape timber with an embedded nail was found mixed with the brush awaiting the Town's brush chipper. See the photo to the right. Just one nail like the one in this landscape timber could have posed a serious hazard for our Public Works sanitation crew. The nail could have cut through their gloves or worse, our crew could have been very seriously injured by having the nail run through chipper and ricochet back towards the crew! Please remember that you can find a free booklet at Town Hall and at Public Works that describes the Town's trash and brush policies. Citizens are encouraged to obtain the booklet and refer to it as you begin spring cleaning around your property.



The safety of the members of our Public Works team is of great concern as they we work to assist the citizens of Weaverville! Thank you for helping us by ensuring that dangerous materials are not left hidden within brush dippings.
